UNIVERSITY OF RAJASTHAN

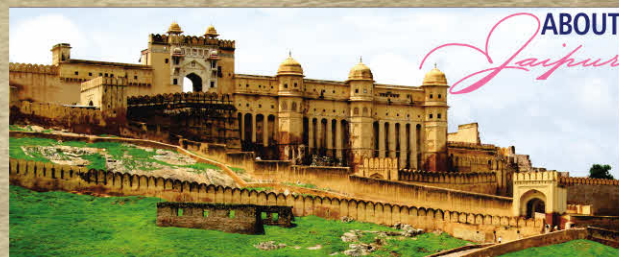
